Seroquel® (quetiapine)

The recommended maximum dose from the package labeling for quetiapine is 800 mg/day; however, evidence supporting higher doses in treatment-resistant patients have been published. Expert consensus statements from the J Clin Psychiatry recommend the highest acute treatment dose be limited to 950 mg/day, while the target dose in treatment-resistant patients can be up to 1100 mg/day. Our quantity limits allow for 1200mg/day.

If you request an expedited review, and sign the attached form, you certify that applying the 72 hour standard review time frame may seriously jeopardize the life or health of the member or the member's ability to regain maximum function.
